

Education Excellence Conclave 2026

Eligibility Criteria

Organised by: CCLP Worldwide

Presented by: UNESCO Club of Education Charter

1. Purpose

The Education Excellence Conclave 2026 seeks to recognise outstanding academic achievement and encourage a culture of excellence, leadership and responsible citizenship among students.

Participation is by **school nomination only**.

Individual student applications are not accepted.

2. Eligible Institutions

The following recognised educational institutions are eligible to participate:

- CBSE Affiliated Schools
 - CISCE (ICSE/ISC) Schools
 - State Board Schools
 - Government Schools
 - Government-Aided Schools
 - Private Recognised Schools
 - Kendriya Vidyalayas
 - Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalayas
 - Other recognised educational institutions approved by the Organising Committee.
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3. Eligible Students

Students must satisfy all of the following conditions:

Category A

Class X Board Examination

Students who successfully passed the Class X Board Examination.

Category B

Class XII Board Examination

Students who successfully passed the Class XII Board Examination.

4. Academic Eligibility

For the inaugural edition of the Education Excellence Conclave 2026:

Students securing

90% or above

in their respective Board Examination are eligible for nomination.

The Organising Committee reserves the right to revise the qualifying percentage in future editions.

5. Nomination Process

Students cannot nominate themselves.

All nominations must be submitted through the respective school.

Each school shall nominate students through the official School Nomination Portal.

6. Verification of Records

The school shall ensure that all submitted information is accurate.

Supporting documents shall include:

- Board Marksheet
- Student Photograph
- Principal's Declaration

- Student Nomination Sheet (prescribed format)

The Organising Committee may request additional verification if required.

7. Number of Nominations

Each participating school may nominate **all eligible students** who satisfy the prescribed academic criteria.

There is **no upper limit** on the number of nominations submitted by a school, provided that each nominated student fulfils the eligibility requirements.

8. Authenticity

The Principal shall certify that:

- all academic records are authentic;
 - marks have been verified;
 - the nominated students fulfil the eligibility criteria;
 - necessary parental consent has been obtained.
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9. Verification by the Organising Committee

The Organising Committee reserves the right to:

- verify submitted documents;
- seek clarification;
- request additional documents;
- reject incomplete or incorrect nominations.

The decision of the Organising Committee shall be final.

10. Recognition

Eligible students successfully verified by the Organising Committee shall receive recognition during the Education Excellence Conclave 2026.

Recognition may include:

- Certificate of Recognition
- Medal of Excellence
- Stage Recognition
- Official Photography
- Media Coverage

Recognition categories may be expanded in future editions.

11. Disqualification

A nomination may be rejected if:

- incorrect information is submitted;
 - supporting documents are incomplete;
 - academic records cannot be verified;
 - the nomination does not satisfy the prescribed eligibility criteria;
 - the Principal's Declaration is not submitted.
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12. General Conditions

Submission of a nomination does not automatically guarantee participation.

The Organising Committee reserves the right to:

- determine the final list of participants;
 - modify programme schedules;
 - amend these eligibility criteria whenever necessary in the interest of the Initiative.
